Visiting a Beekeeper

In June, the kindergarten group learned about bees. There were many interesting things to learn and the preschool group even got to visit a beekeeper.

The beekeeper told and showed how the bees develop during their life, what their tasks are, how they find their own hive and that the flowers have completely different colours for them.

He showed a bee hive and its entrance, where the queen lives, where the combs are and how he harvests the honey.

The children learned how to behave when dealing with bees and why a beekeeper wears white clothes.



At the end, we were able to taste and compare 7 different honeys. Which one do you like the best? Which one do you not like at all?

We bought an acacia honey and a sunflower honey to show the different tastes, colours and consistency to the other younger children.
